

CT FCCLA LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE RULES OF CONDUCT

Attendance at a CT FCCLA Conference is an exciting experience and holds responsibilities for the members who attend. These rules are set to help you and others enjoy our conference. Please help us by following all the rules listed below.

1. There is no smoking allowed during any CT FCCLA meetings. To protect the health of everyone attending the conference, there will be no designated smoking areas.
2. The use of drugs or alcohol will not be permitted at any time.
3. Delegates are an extension of the schools and communities that they represent. Make your families, schools and communities proud of your behavior. The rights and comfort of everyone is important. The noise level, language, and general conduct of all conference participants should impart a positive image to all those around us.
4. Advise your advisors of your whereabouts at all times and recognize the authority of advisors and state officers. Delegates are to take part in all activities for which they are scheduled. Attendance will be taken. If you are scheduled for a workshop, that's where you should be.
5. Any damages to property of our host facility or the personal property of others are the responsibility of both the individual responsible and his/her chapter. Restitution would be expected.
6. Delegates should wear their "best school clothes" or "business attire". Absolutely no hats, shorts, skimpy tops, or T-shirts with pictures or writing are acceptable. Pants that are jeans or 'sloppy' are not allowed. Shoes that are difficult to walk in are not appropriate as there will be a fair amount of walking.
7. Any rules set by your own school will also apply.

Violation of any of these rules will be sufficient cause for discontinuing the delegate's participation in the conference and sending the delegate(s) home. This action may result in an entire chapter having to leave the conference before it is completed, therefore delegates should consider their behavior at all times.

Rules of Conduct

- Behavior at conference. Students and their parents/guardians should each sign a copy of the Rules of Conduct before you leave for the meeting.
