

**CT FCCLA SKILL EVENT**  
**Textile Art**

The Textile Arts Skill Event, an individual event, recognizes participants for their skill and creativity in developing a textile craft and their ability to explain the techniques involved.

**EVENT CATEGORIES**

1. Junior: through grade 9                      Senior: grades 10 – 12

**ELIGIBILITY**

1. An event category is determined by the participant's grade in school.
2. Participation is open to any CT FCCLA chapter member.
3. Two students or two teams can compete for each 10 members affiliated.

**PURPOSE**

To provide the opportunity for students to demonstrate and exhibit skill in a textile art and to explain the techniques used and the uses of the items.

**SPECIFICATIONS**

1. Project must be an original textile design.
2. No kits may be used.
3. The participant should bring the finished item to be displayed.
4. The participant should bring a brief written description including materials used, cost, techniques used, and planned use of the item.
5. The participant will have a maximum of five (5) minutes to describe techniques used, etc.
6. Evaluators will be allowed five (5) minutes to ask questions of the participants.
7. Entrant's adviser must verify that the textile art was an original design, made by entrant as part of a family and consumer sciences class or an FCCLA project.
8. The following information should be submitted on a 3" x 5" index card to the event consultant during the Orientation session.
