

CT FCCLA SKILL EVENT
TEXTILE ART

Textile Arts Skill Event, an individual event, recognizes participants for their skill and creativity in developing a textile craft and their ability to explain the techniques involved.

EVENT CATEGORIES

1. Junior: through grade 9
2. Senior: grades 10-12

ELIGIBILITY

1. An event category is determined by the participant's grade in school during the school year preceding the National Leadership Meeting.
2. Participation is open to any CT FCCLA chapter member.
3. Qualifying chapters may enter 1 individual for every 10 affiliated chapter members with a maximum of 3 entrants.

1-10 affiliated members	1 entrant per event
11-20 affiliated members	2 entrants per event
21 or more affiliated members	3 entrants per event

PURPOSE

To provide the opportunity for students to demonstrate and exhibit skill in a textile art and to explain the techniques used and the uses of the item.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. Project must be an original textile design.
2. No kits may be used
3. The participant should bring the finished item to be displayed.
4. The participant should bring brief written description including materials used, cost, techniques used and planned use of item.
5. The participant will have a maximum of five (5) minutes to describe techniques uses, etc.
6. Evaluators will be allowed five (5) minutes to ask questions of the participant.
7. Entrant's teacher must verify that the textile art was an original design, made by entrant as part of a family and consumer sciences class or an FCCLA project.
8. The following information should be submitted on a 3"x 5" inch index card to the event consultant during the Orientation Session.
